The Estimating Process at E.A.S Windows to meet all Fensa Requirements

We at E.A.S Windows strive to offer the very best advice and service that we can. All our estimators have spent many years in the Window and Building Industry and have a wealth of knowledge and experience.

During our initial visit we will have discussed and allowed for the following key issues in relation to the windows and doors we hope to provide for you. These products are governed by various Building Regulations and British Standards, all of which are covered under the FENSA scheme.

- Part A - Structural stability of large window frames and doors.
- Part B - The provision to provide adequate fire escape routes through opening windows and doors.
- Part F - The provision to provide adequate natural ventilation through opening lights and trickle vents when required.
- Part K - This requires us to consider the safety of opening vents onto passage ways and restrictions of opening vents in vulnerable locations.
- Part L - The Green issue, and the requirements for all products in your home to be as energy efficient as possible, thus all our installations now include for low E energy saving glass.
- Part M - This requires us to consider the requirement for disabled and wheel chair access through new doors.
- Part N - The requirements for safety glazing in critical areas i.e. doors and low level screens and windows. Security of vulnerable areas and the possible use of laminated safety glass.
- BS 8213 - The provision for safe internal or external cleaning of all windows and doors. We will also advise on design options where necessary and discuss the safe use of ladders for external cleaning.
The facility to provide remote operation to high level vents which are difficult to reach in normal circumstances.
